

Lafayette Bobcat Football 2011 Picture and Weigh-in Day

All players **must** arrive at the park **15 minutes BEFORE** their team's first session (photos or weigh-in's) for attendance and preparation. **REMINDER: please bring your concession stand donation to the park.**

The 12 year old team will be selling pizza and drinks at the park shelter to raise funds for LBF.

Steven Hoffer Photography will be taking individual and team photos. Coaches and/or team parents have the photo ordering packets and will be distributing them. Players must **wear their entire game uniform** for the photo session (black pants, shoulder pads, socks, cleats, and game jersey.) **Teams with maroon and white jerseys should bring both.** Photo schedule is as follows:

4:30 7/8 year olds
4:50 9 year olds
5:10 10 year olds
5:30 11 year olds
5:50 12 year olds

Weigh-Ins

Taking every player's weight is required to ensure compliance with CCMFL rules regarding positions on offense and defense. Check www.lafayettebobcats.com to download a copy of the CCMFL rules. ***If you cannot make the weigh-in session on the 23rd at Waneka Lake, an "alternate" session is scheduled for Thursday, August 18th, 5:30-6:30 pm at Miner's Field in Louisville.***

If your child fails to make either session, per CCMFL rules, a penalty weight will be added to your child's actual weight (after being weighed by a representative from another CCMFL chapter.) Players falling into this penalty situation cannot participate in games until their weight and penalty pounds are recorded. See page 6, Rule 9, of the [2011 CCMFL Official Rules](#) for further explanation of this rule.

Officials from LBF and from one other CCMFL team will be on-hand to measure, verify, and record your player's weight. Your child can get on the scale in full uniform, or t-shirt/shorts, or down to his underwear if he desires. You cannot weigh in twice -- if you attend the alternate session on August 18th and weighed in, you will not be able to record your weight on the 23rd. Weigh-in schedule is as follows:

4:30 12 year olds
4:50 7/8 year olds
5:10 9 year olds
5:30 10 year olds
5:50 11 year olds
